Risk Assessment	500	Hourly rate ⁽¹⁾ x time ⁽²⁾	Minimum charge of £50 for admin etc
Sampling	100	£74	Charge for a visit and to take a sample
Investigation	100	Hourly rate + any analysis costs	Carried out by the Council in the event of the failure of a supply to meet the required standard
Authorisation	100	Hourly rate x time	Application by the owner of a supply for permission from the Council to continue supplying water of a lower quality temporarily whilst remedial work is carried out on the supply
Analysis:-			
-Under Reg. 10 (Domestic Supplies)	25	£13.50	Where a supply provides ³ <math><10\text{m}^3</math> /day or , <math><50</math> people and is used for domestic purposes
-Check Monitoring (Commercial Supplies)	100	£38.25 for boreholes ⁽³⁾ £56.50 for all other types of supply including springs, wells, etc ⁽³⁾	Check monitoring is carried out to ensure that water complies with the standards. Where possible it should be carried out at the same time as any requirement for Audit monitoring, to keep cost down
-Audit Monitoring (Commercial Supplies)	500	£40.50 + cost of check monitoring ⁽³⁾ (£78.75 for boreholes, all others including springs, wells, etc £97)	Additional parameters are sampled to ensure the water complies with all safety standards

2. Sampling cost not applied to risk assessment
3. Sampling cost applied to Check/Audit Monitoring
