Information in the tables

School Details

- Address and telephone number.
- Age range of pupils normally admitted to the school.
- Type of school (CY, VA or VC). **CY:** Community school maintained by the local education authority (LEA). The LEA is the admissions authority: it has main responsibility for deciding arrangements for admitting pupils. **VA:** Voluntary aided school maintained by the LEA, with a foundation (generally religious), which appoints most of the governing body. The governing body is the admissions authority. **VC:** Voluntary controlled school maintained by the LEA, with a foundation (generally religious), which appoints some, but not most, of the governing body. The LEA is the admissions authority.

Background Information

- The total number of pupils of all ages, including nursery pupils, at the school.
- The number of pupils who reached the age of 11 during the school year.
- The total number and % of pupils in the school with statements of special educational needs. These statements describe learning difficulties that pupils have, and specify the extra help or equipment they need. Around 3% of school pupils nationally have statements.
- The total number and % of pupils in the school with special needs, without statements. These are other pupils registered as having special educational

needs but whose schools meet the pupils' needs without a statement.

- If a school has a large proportion of pupils with special educational needs, its results may appear lower than expected (although some pupils with special educational needs are academically able).

Pupils Eligible for Key Stage 2 Assessment

All pupils, including those with special educational needs, are eligible for assessment under the National Curriculum when they reach the end of Key Stage 2. Most will be aged 11 by the end of the school year, although some will be younger or older. The number of pupils who were eligible for assessment in each school is shown, together with the number and % of those pupils who had special educational needs (with and without statements).

KS2 Results: % Achieving Level 4 or Above

- The tables show the percentage of eligible pupils achieving Level 4 or above in English, Maths and Science tests, and in teachers assessments (TAs).
- Level 4 is the level of achievement *expected* of pupils at the end of Key Stage 2.
- Please note that care should be taken when comparing the results of schools of different sizes: in smaller schools, it only needs one pupil to achieve a different result for the school's percentage figure to look very different. Fifty percent could mean 5 out of 10 pupils, or 50 out of 100.

KS2 Results: Absent or Disapplied Pupils

- Some pupils did not take some or all of the tests because they were absent from school, and as a result did not achieve a

test level. Similarly, in some cases a high level of absence, for example, due to long-term illness, meant that a pupil could not be teacher assessed.

- Not all pupils follow the full National Curriculum. Usually, this only happens if all or part of the curriculum is not suitable for a pupil because he or she has certain special educational needs. Such pupils are termed 'disapplied'.
- In accordance with DfES guidelines, a school's results are based on the achievements of *all* its eligible pupils, including absent and disapplied pupils. This means that the results for a school with a significant number of absent or disapplied pupils will be markedly lower than they would otherwise be. In order to take this into account within the parameters set by the DfES, the percentage of pupils who were absent or disapplied for the test is shown beneath, in brackets. The higher the percentage, the more the school's results will have been affected by pupils with no results.

KS2 Results: Average Point Score

The results at Level 4 and above would show the same figure no matter how many children achieved above the expected level (i.e. level 5 or 6). The Average Point Score attempts to take into account the full spectrum of levels achieved. (See section "Interpreting the Performance").

Improvement Measures

This contains a graph for the years 1999 to 2002. It shows the total of the three percentages (English, Maths & Science tests), of pupils achieving Level 4 or above,

as published in the tables for each of the four years.

Absence Record

- The number of pupils of compulsory school age excludes nursery school children.
- Authorised absence is when it has been authorised by the school.

Local and national averages

The foot of each page shows:

- the average test figures for all state schools in the local education authority area
- the average test figures for all state schools in England

These figures include the results of eligible pupils in special schools.

Interpreting the Results

Users of the information contained in this publication should be aware that while performance tables have some value, there are many things about schools and pupils that aren't shown.

Percentage Level 4+

- The national curriculum at Key Stage 2 is assessed according to a 9 level scale. On average, pupils will progress one level every two years, and each level represents a very broad range of achievement. Pupils at the top of level three will be performing similarly to those at the bottom of level 4, but both sets of pupils will be performing less well than those at the top of level 4.

- Focusing on the percentage achieving level 4 and above does not properly represent the achievement of schools that have, for example, large numbers of pupils who achieved level 5.
- The Average Point Score attempts to take into account the number of children at each level by assigning a number of points to each level. (The points assigned are: Below L3=15 points, L3=21, L4=27, L5=33 and L6=39). Absent or disappplied children are not included in the calculation, so it is based purely on the children who actually took the test.
- The Average Point Score shown is the average of the tests in the 3 subjects, English, Maths and Science. An APS of 24.0, for example means that the average level achieved is halfway between level 3 and level 4.

Progress of the year group

The most important information not shown is the progress pupils have made in the school. This is because the pupils' previous performance is not taken into account. Therefore, although the percentage of pupils achieving level 4 and above in a school may seem low, examining their performance on starting at the school may show that they have made very good progress.

Improvement Measure: results over time

- Note that schools' results will vary from year to year depending on the abilities of different groups of pupils, and as a result, any of the four years shown may be unusually high or low compared with other years.

- Where there is no figure, the graph for the school shows 'NA'. This may be because, in a given year, the school did not exist, or it had less than 11 eligible pupils, or the total cannot be calculated due to incomplete results (e.g., for reasons beyond the school's control).

Salford and National averages

Comparing a school's results with equivalent LEA and national figures can be misleading. Research has shown that schools with different intakes do achieve different results. A school that appears to have low results may in fact have pupils of lower ability than the norm, and may be doing very well in getting them to the level of achievement shown in these tables. Similarly, schools with a high ability intake would be expected to achieve higher results, and they may look better than they actually are when compared with LEA or national figures.
