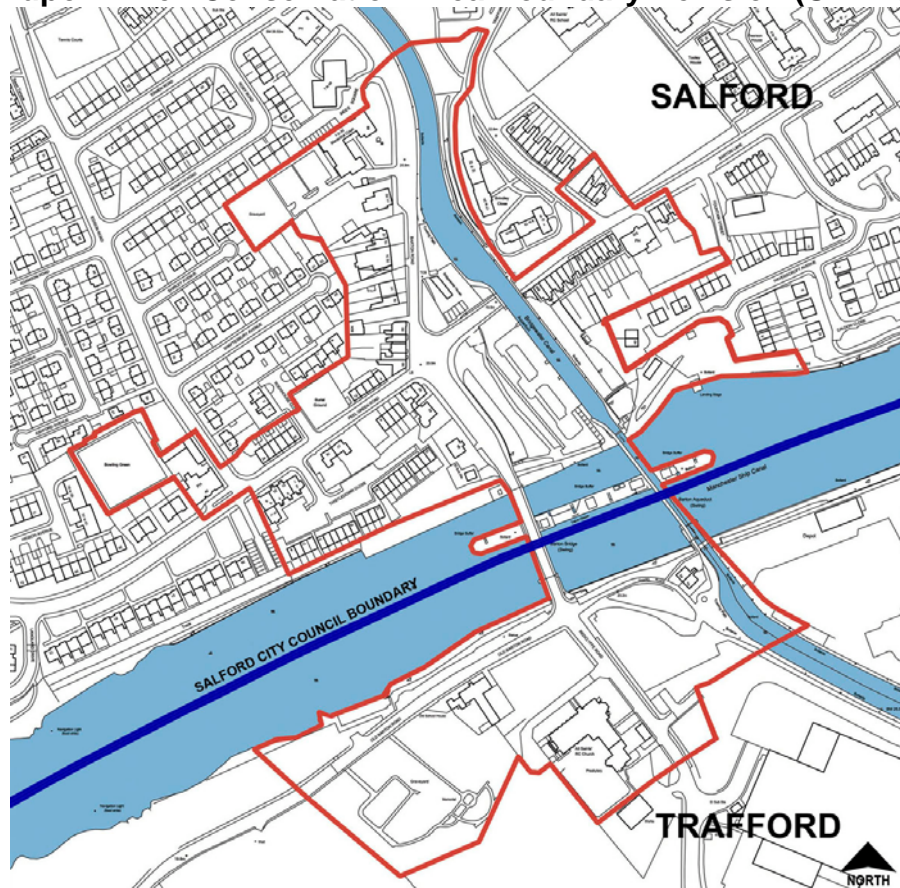
Application of Policies CH3 and CH4 following completion of Conservation Area Appraisals

In accordance with relevant national guidance (Section 69 and Section 71 of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990 and PPG 15: Planning and the Historic Environment), Salford City Council is carrying out a programme of conservation area appraisals. To date, three conservation area appraisals have been undertaken, covering Barton-upon-Irwell, Worsley Village, and Adelphi and Bexley Square Conservation Areas. These appraisals have been subject to public consultation.

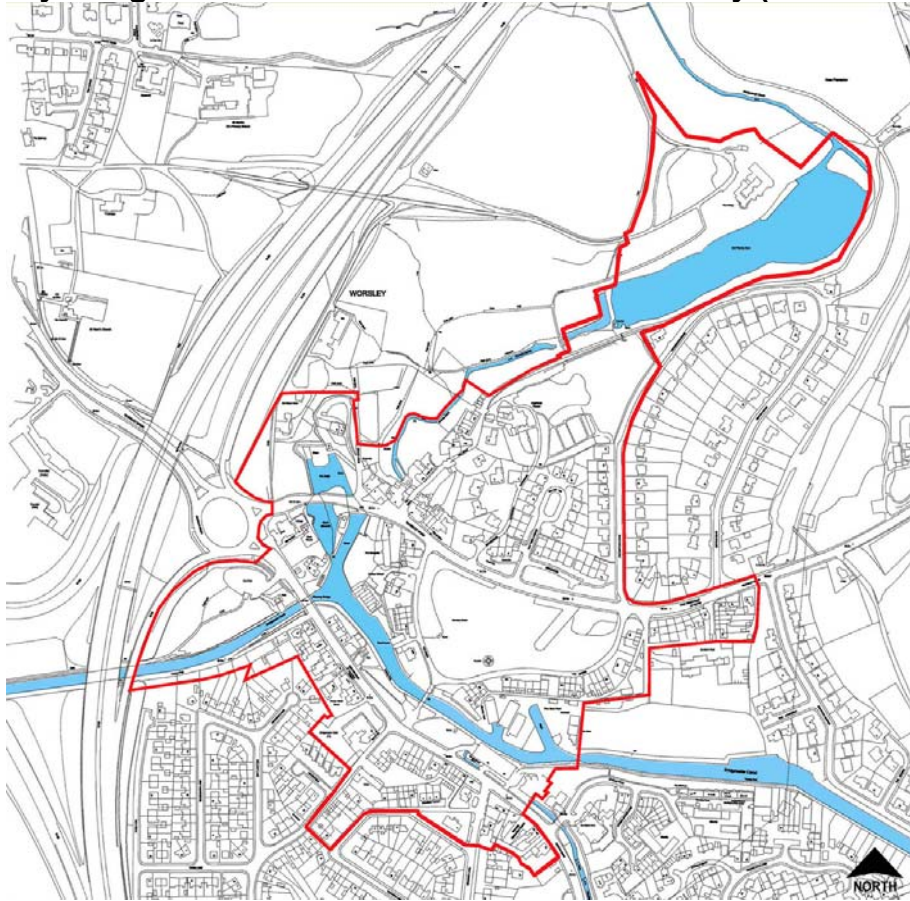
As a consequence, on July 18th 2007, the city council adopted revised boundaries for the Barton-upon-Irwell and Worsley Village Conservation Areas (which can be seen on the plans below). UDP policies CH3 and CH4 will now be applied within these revised boundaries.

The Adelphi and Bexley Square Conservation Area appraisal resulted in no alteration of its existing boundary.
